For those who have carried out at least 3 years of university studies in English in an English-speaking country the mark is 15 out of 20. <u>If you have a standardised English test we recommend that you submit it with the online application. We will take the higher of the two marks.</u></p> <p>** In the event that submission of one of these tests is not possible, you may request to take a replacement test (SHL) on one of our campuses.</p> <p>Important note: You will be invited to the interview only in case you will be declared admissible.</p>
